BEHAVIOUR EXPECTATIONS AND CONSEQUENCES

Trip Destination: Richard B. Russell State Park, Elberton, Georgia, USA

1. The supervising coaches and chaperones have complete authority during this activity. Students are expected to follow instructions at all time. This includes such conditions as curfews, room assignments, restricted areas and activities they are allowed to participate in.
2. Every effort will be made to ensure student's safety. There may be times during the trip when students will not be directly supervised and will be expected to accept responsibility for their own safety and behaviour.
3. Students must adhere to the Code of Conduct as laid out by the Peterborough Rowing Club (PRC) and must NOT:
 - smoke on the bus, during the activity or whenever prohibited by the supervisor
 - use or be in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs
4. Consequences for inappropriate behaviour could include: failure to further participate in this activity, failure to participate in future PRC activities, being charged by the police if criminal activity is involved and/or being sent home early at personal expense.
